Job Description Summary

Position: The School of Communication and Journalism at Auburn University seeks candidates for a Lecturer position in Communication beginning Fall semester, Aug. 16, 2024. Responsibilities: This is a teaching-intensive position in the undergraduate Communication program. The primary responsibility of the successful candidate is to teach a range of in-person, on-campus sophomore and junior-level communication courses (such as Rhetoric & Social Influence, Argumentation, Conflict Communication, Persuasion, and Advanced Public Speaking) as well as some senior-level courses (such as Political Communication, Legal Communication, Nonverbal Communication), during the Fall and Spring semesters. Supplemental support for summer instruction may be possible depending on need and availability of funding. Candidates should indicate in their cover letters the courses they are qualified to teach.
