\* WPI is seeking a full-time non-tenure track faculty to teach 20th-century U.S. history, (emphases open, but with preference for such areas as labor, diplomacy, and environment);

### Position Requirements

\* Ph.D. in history and experience teaching history at the college level are required. This 9-month faculty position starts in August 2018. WPI operates on 4 7-week terms. The new faculty will teach 2 courses per term.
