Positions may range from 17% to 100% time during the academic year, while summer appointments are handled on a by-agreement basis.

Job duties: Successful applicants will teach in CWP's Reading and Composition sequence or other CWP courses in writing, reading, and oral communication. They will have complete responsibility for

classes to include teaching in a classroom environment, meeting with students during scheduled weekly office hours and by appointment, and grading student work.

Basic qualifications (at time of application): Advanced degree or enrolled in an advanced degree program at the time of application.

Additional qualifications (by start date): Completion of advanced degree and two years of experience teaching university-level composition are required by the start date.

Foreign applicants must also have permission to work in the U.S. by start date.

Preferred qualifications: A Ph.D. or equivalent international degree in one of the following fields by the start date of the position:

- * composition studies
- * rhetoric and composition
- * digital rhetoric
- * second-language writing/ESL/applied linguistics
- * education.

Three years or more of experience teaching university-level composition.
Evidence of clear writing as presented in application materials.

Salary: \$54,378-\$94,233 annual rate during academic year; by agreement in Summer Sessions.
