Position Summary

The University of North Texas invites applications for a full-time Lecturer to begin as early as fall of 2022. The candidate will have a commitment to teaching professional and technical communication courses to a diverse student body. Service activities will include directing undergraduate student recruitment and developing online course materials. As director of student recruiting, the candidate will be responsible for establishing a strategic marketing plan for the recruitment of BA/BS majors and coordinating with others in the department (e.g., Undergraduate Advisor, Student Ambassadors, etc.) to advance departmental goals for student recruitment.

This position is expected to teach 8 course sections per academic year. This position will be hired on a renewable, 9-month contract with full state benefits and other perks (e.g., tuition/fee waivers for the employee and dependents). This position includes a path to promotion.
