- The minimum educational credential required for the applicant is a **master's degree in Communication**, or a related field, with an **emphasis on media criticism and media literacy**.
- Candidates with a doctoral degree in Mass Communication or Communication with a focus on media literacy and criticism are preferred.
- A candidate with only a master's degree will be hired at the rank of lecturer. A candidate with a doctoral degree will be hired at the rank of Assistant Teaching professor. The degree must be completed by the time of application.
- **Full-time faculty normally teach four courses per semester.** The successful candidate will have college teaching experience and a commitment to university service and public outreach. Previous experience in advising and mentoring students is preferred.

This is a TERM, non-tenure track appointment with the possibility of reappointment,(36 weeks).
