Candidates may have a research focus in any aspect of 20th and 21st-Century Anglophone poetry and poetics, with preference given to candidates whose interests and expertise not only include poetry from North America, the United Kingdom, and Ireland, but who address English-language poetry from around the globe, including Africa, Australia, the Caribbean, and South Asia. We seek candidates whose work has a global reach, considering the field of Anglophone poetry and poetics in its increasingly international context. Formalist and/or philosophical approaches to poetry and poetics are welcome. Secondary attention to other genres and diverse medial forms is also welcome. The successful candidate will be expected to teach a broad range of undergraduate courses and graduate seminars, to mentor students writing senior theses and doctoral dissertations, and to participate in

Qualifications

Application requirements: a letter of application; CV; a writing sample (no more than 25 pages); and three letters of recommendation, submitted directly by the authors and uploaded to Interfolio.
