The Department offers an undergraduate degree in English Studies (focusing simultaneously on literary studies and linguistics), as well as elective courses in translation studies. At the graduate level the Department hosts two MA programmes in (i) English Studies and (ii) Translation and PhD degrees in either (a) Literary Studies or (b) Linguistics. Applicants should be able to demonstrate competence in teaching, promising potential publication, a willingness to provide service to the University and the English Department, and an interest in the English language in Asian contexts.
