The teaching load is four courses per year, with an additional expectation to create programming, such as lectures, workshops, or symposia, in conjunction with the Conway Center for Entrepreneurship and Innovation.

They include artificial intelligence, machine learning, and machine ethics; the ethical conduct of scientific research; and the gathering and use of data in commercial, medical, financial, and social contexts. All eligible individuals are encouraged to apply, and all applications will be given careful consideration.
