**Job Description** 

The Department of Romance Studies at Tufts University invites applications for a Portuguese Language Coordinator and Part-time Lecturer position to begin September 1, 2025.

Part time lecturer to teach all level of Portuguese language courses and coordinate the Portuguese language program. Responsibilities include:

- Teaching up to five Portuguese language courses annually (three in the Fall, two in the Spring);
- Coordinating all levels of Portuguese;
- Overseeing the entire Portuguese language curriculum;
- Hiring, supervising, and evaluating Portuguese lecturers and teaching assistants;
- Coordinating and administering placement exams;



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- Advising students;
- Collaborating with various university offices;
- Maintaining liaison with Global Education programs;
- Promoting the program by organizing co-curricular and outreach events.

### Qualifications

- Masters' degree required in Luso-Brazilian studies, second language acquisition, linguistics, or a related field. PhD preferred.
- Native or near-native fluency in Portuguese and English.
- Detail-oriented, strong organizational skills.
- Team-management, interpersonal and leadership skills.
- Experience in designing and teaching college-level Portuguese language and culture courses in the U.S.
- Command of instructional technology applied to language learning.
- Evidence of creative pedagogical practice reflecting knowledge of current methodologies.
- Evidence of a commitment to designing curricula that address issues of equity and justice with a focus on marginalized communities.
