Duties include teaching 7-8 courses per academic year with the possibility of curriculum development or service to the department. We are seeking candidates with professional and/or teaching experience in strategic communication, including at least two of the following areas: research methods for strategic communication, ethics, data insights, consumer insights, account management, media planning, sports promotion, strategic visual communication, and elective courses across the integrated disciplines of advertising, public relations and sales promotion.

Appointment may be renewed for additional terms based on departmental needs, funding ability, and candidate performance. A terminal degree or a master's degree in strategic communication or related field and relevant professional experience are required; college-level teaching experience is preferred.
