Qualifications: Master's degree from an accredited college and two years of professional experience in higher education is required. At least one year of this experience must be in the administration of operational processes or academic programming. A Doctoral degree (Ph.D., Ed.D., or equivalent) from an accredited institution is preferred and may be substituted for the two years of required experience. Experience teaching African American Studies or Africana Studies and experience working in PK-12 districts is preferred. Candidate must have excellent oral and written communication skills and effective interpersonal skills.

The deadline for applications is August 12, 2025. **Please submit your cover letter, resume/CV and contact information for three professional references.** Official transcripts are required prior to the starting date of employment.
