In addition, requirements at the Associate Professor and Full Professor level include:

- Recognition in the research community, such as invited talks, awards, or memberships in professional societies.
- · Proven ability to secure research funding.
- Demonstrated capacity to contribute to curriculum development.
- A strong track record of supervising students, research staff, and/or postdocs, as well as mentoring junior faculty.
- Experience in leadership and/or service roles.
