A Master's degree (NQF Level 9) in Broadcast Journalism, Journalism, Radio Production, Film and Television Production or a master's degree in a related area with at least four (4) years of lecturing and/or industrial experience and/or an equivalent combination of relevant professional experience. Excellent English communication skills (oral and written). Competence to teach at least three (3) of the following courses: Broadcast Journalism, Audio-Visual Media, Radio Production, Television Production, Documentary Production, Scriptwriting, Postproduction Practice and Graphic Design. Competence in operating professional audio broadcast equipment, professional electronic newsgathering, studio and electronic field production cameras, including DSLR cameras, setting up and operating a full radio production studio and podcasting studio. Competence in establishing professional networks and maintaining links with the industry, as well as experience in developing undergraduate programmes.
